### Halsey's "Manic" First Album to Go Certified Platinum in 2020

Halsey's "Manic" went RIAA-certified platinum Feb. 26, making it the first album of 2020 to do so.

"Manic" came out Jan. 17 and is Halsey's third studio album, following "Badlands" and "Hopeless Fountain Kingdom."

"Manic"'s lead single "Without Me" went platinum Dec. 16, and another single from the album "Graveyard" went gold the same day.

Halsey revealed "Manic" was originally supposed to be an angry album. However, following her single "Nightmare," she found herself writing a "calm and introspective" record.

"Manic" features tracks about heartbreak, about feeling sorry for someone who wronged you, about loving women, and more. The album is versatile and different from her others. There are also features from Dominic Fike, Alanis Morissette and BTS. Some tracks sample audio from movies as well, creating a story with the music.

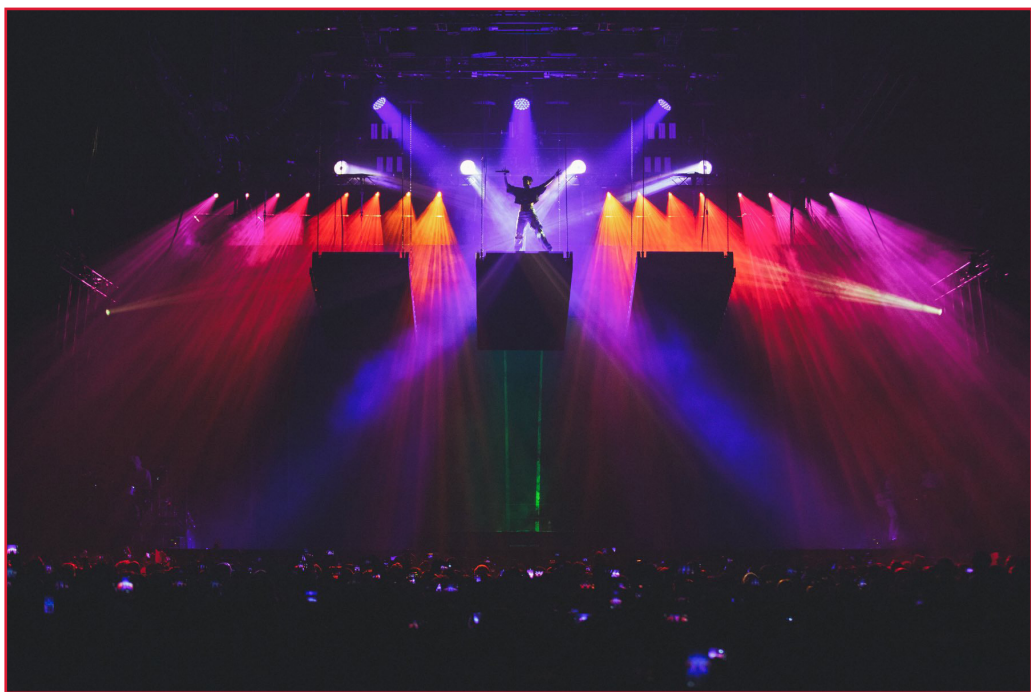
