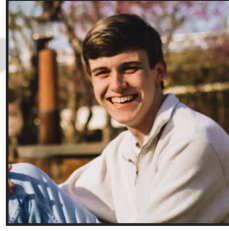
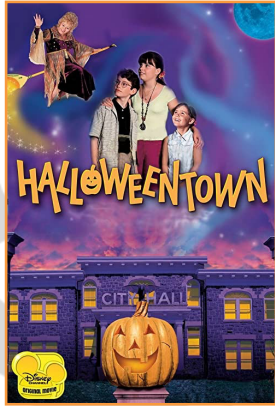
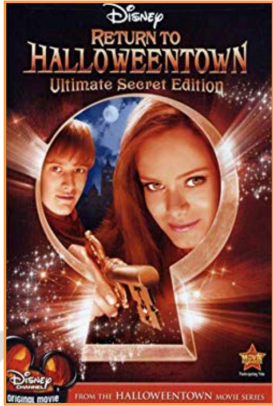

Courtney Edwards, Editor-In-Chief, is a senior multimedia journalism major from Cave City.

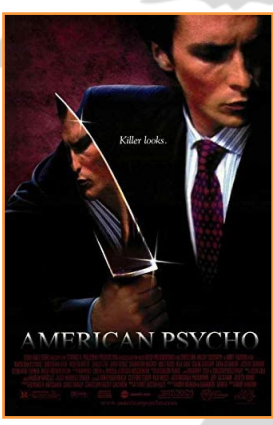


Jonathan Schaufler, News Editor, is a freshman multimedia journalism major from Salem.

Edwards and Schaufler both chose movies from Disney's "Halloweentown" series as their favorite movie to watch during the Halloween season.



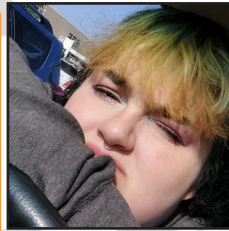
Lily Cabibi-Wilkin, Opinion Editor, is a senior music composition major from Hot Springs. Her Halloween movie pick is "American Psycho."



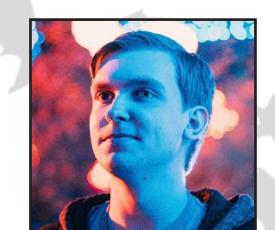
Rebecca Robinson, Sports Editor, is a junior multimedia journalism major from Sheridan. Her movie recommendation is "The Haunted Mansion."
