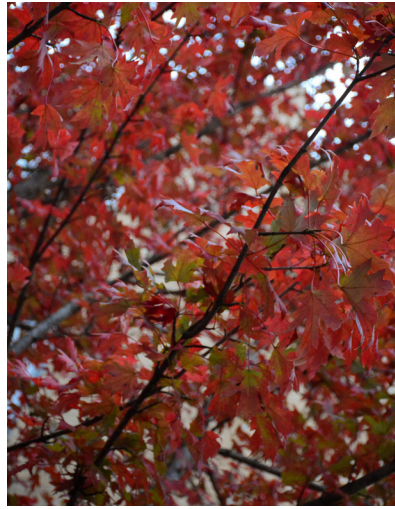

Autumn at A-State



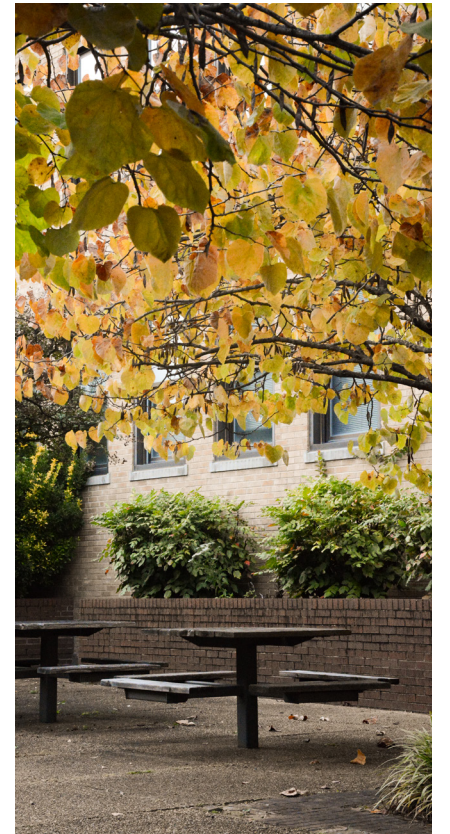
Autumn has finally found the Arkansas State University campus, one falling leaf at a time.



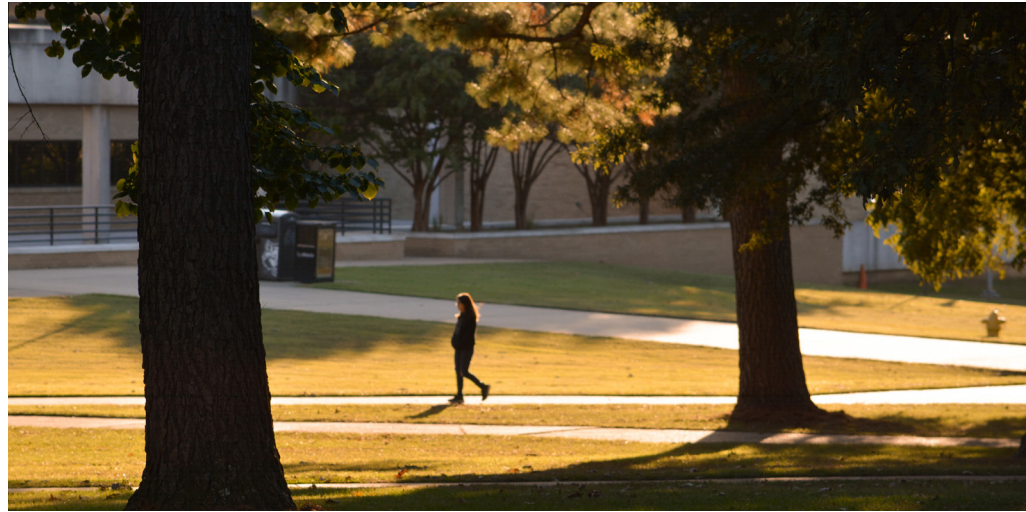
Red leaves changing on a tree.

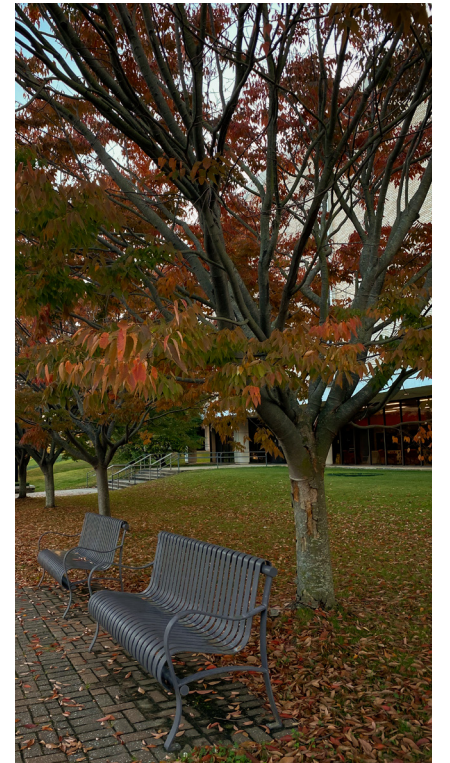

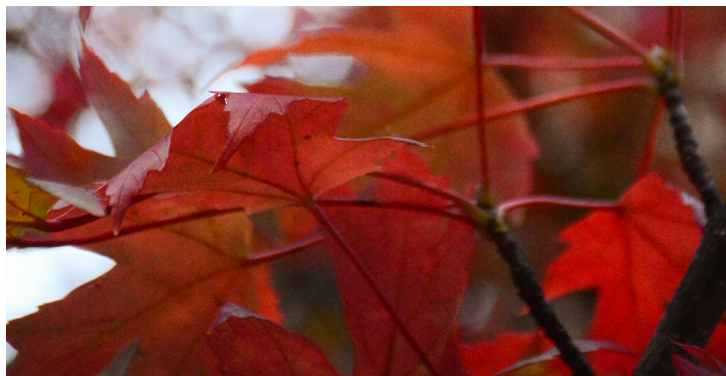
