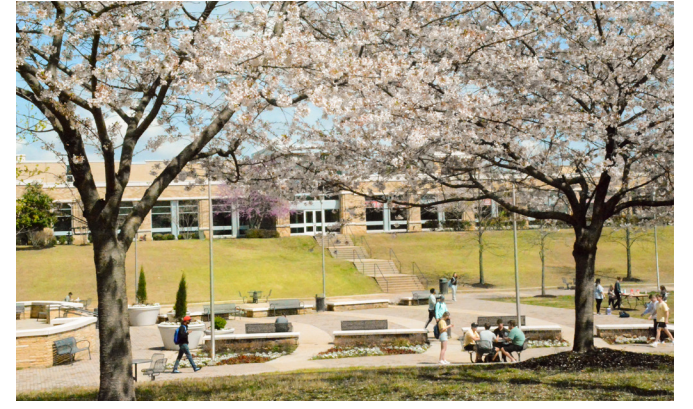
Spring Has Finally Arrived at A-State



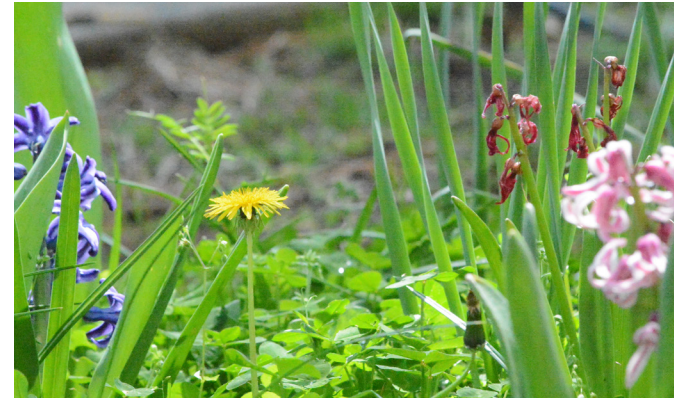
Flowering trees, buzzing bees, and a gentle spring breeze have finally come to campus.

The flowers and clovers are a welcome sight after the long and snowy winter months.



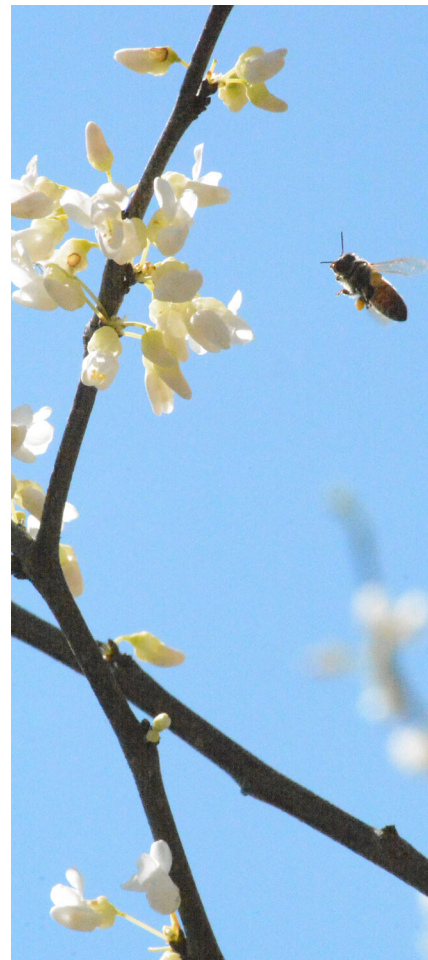
Flowering trees decorate the landscape around the Humanities and Social Sciences Building.



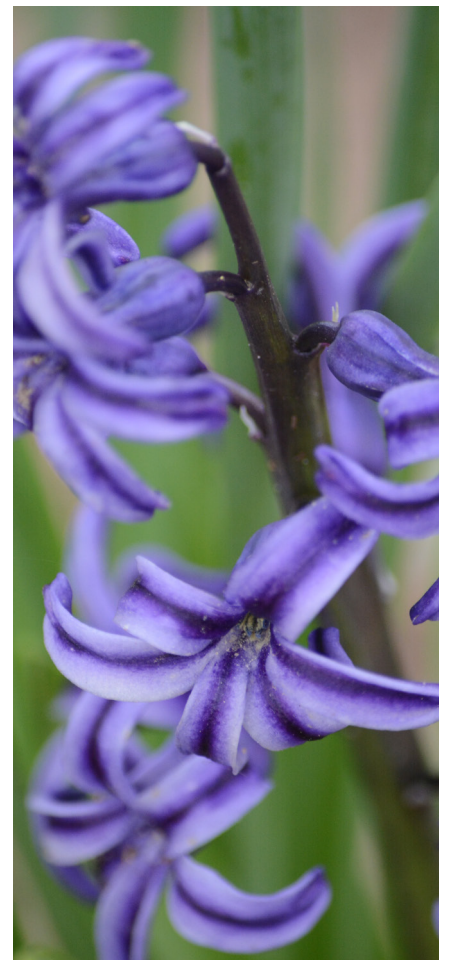
Spring buds and ivy decorate the beautiful A-State campus.



A student enjoys a nice walk outside the Reng Student Union.



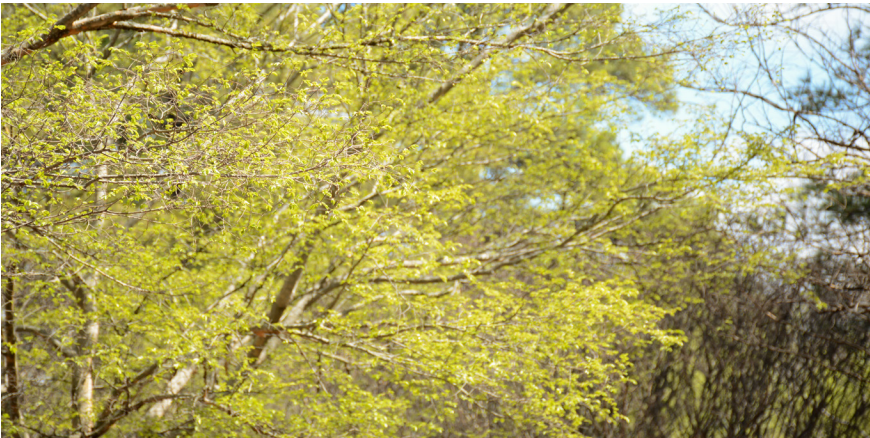
Contributing to pollination, a little bee flies to a flower for nectar.



Vibrant flowers bloom outside of the Dean B. Ellis Library.



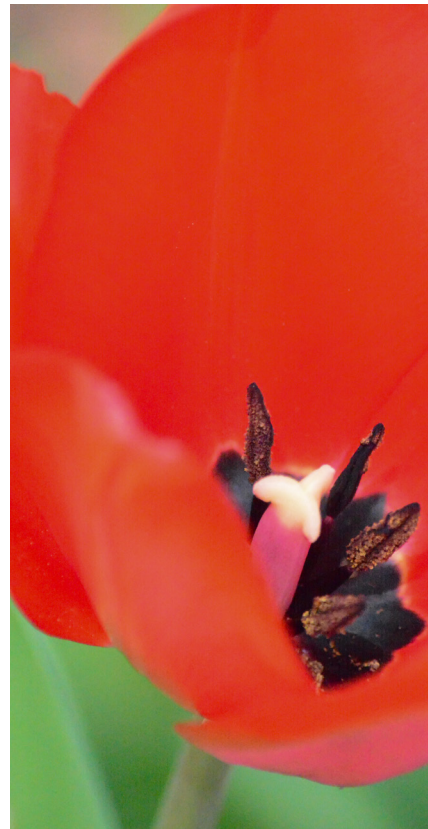

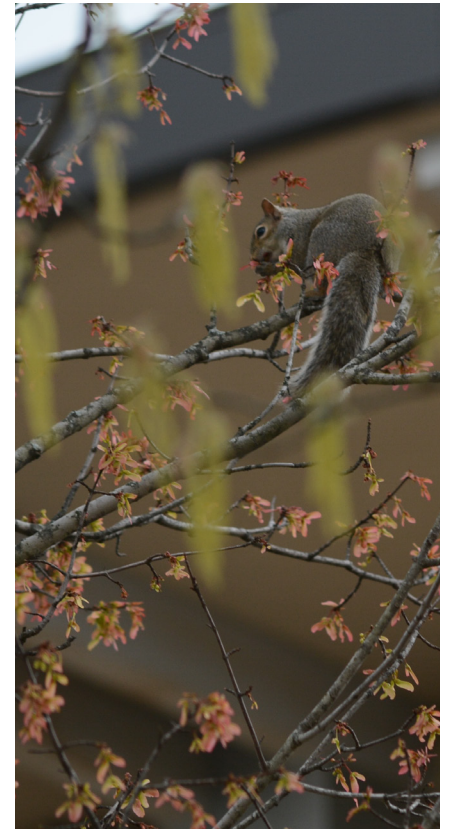
Warm weather and sunshine has come to Jonesboro.
